### **From the Rector, Synod this week**

This weekend our annual Diocesan Synod (meaning - gathering) meets at Kelso in Bathurst. Our parish representatives attending this year are Therese Garnsey, Michelle Lyons (in place of Deb McLean, who is not available, and I. A big focus of the Synod will be celebrating the new Strategic Plan, with the catch phrase – Sharing Jesus for Life. There is also a lot of update material from the General Synod (Australia wide) relating to child protection and professional conduct. The other main motion is an encouragement for people across the diocese to make use of the resource, “Sharing our Story”, produced by the organisation Australians Together which encourages Reconciliation.

### **Remember Queen Elizabeth II**

On Saturday 24 September at 6pm we are holding a special service to give thanks to God for the Life and Witness of Queen Elizabeth II. My hope is that people from the community will attend this service, and that it will be helpful time of memorial and thanksgiving for the Queen who is the Defender of the Faith!

### **Sentence**

You know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that by his poverty you might become rich. 2 Corinthians 8.9

### **Jeremiah 8.18-9.1**

<sup>18</sup> You who are my Comforter in sorrow, my heart is faint within me. <sup>19</sup> Listen to the cry of my people from a land far away: 'Is the Lord not in Zion? Is her King no longer there?' 'Why have they aroused my anger with their images, with their worthless foreign idols?' <sup>20</sup> 'The harvest is past, the summer has ended, and we are not saved.' <sup>21</sup> Since my people are crushed, I am crushed; I mourn, and horror grips me. <sup>22</sup> Is there no balm in Gilead? Is there no physician there? Why then is there no healing for the wound of my people? <sup>1</sup> Oh, that my head were a spring of water and my eyes a fountain of tears! I would weep day and night for the slain of my people.

### **Psalm 79.1-9**

- <sup>1</sup> O God, the heathen have come into your land:  
**they have defiled your holy temple,  
they have made Jerusalem a heap of stones.**
- <sup>2</sup> They have given the dead bodies of your servants  
as food to the birds of the air:  
**and the flesh of your faithful ones  
to the wild beasts of the earth.**
- <sup>3</sup> Their blood they have spilt like water  
on every side of Jerusalem:  
**and there is none to bury them.**
- <sup>4</sup> We have become a mockery to our neighbours:  
**the scorn and laughing-stock of those about us.**
- <sup>5</sup> How long, O Lord, shall your anger be so extreme:  
**will your jealous fury burn like fire?**

- <sup>6</sup> Pour out your wrath on the nations that do not know you:  
**on the kingdoms that have not called upon your name.**
- <sup>7</sup> For they have devoured Jacob:  
**and made his dwelling-place a desolation.**
- <sup>8</sup> Do not remember against us the sin of former times:  
**but let your compassion hasten to meet us,  
for we are brought very low.**
- <sup>9</sup> Help us, O God our saviour,  
for the honour of your name:  
**O deliver us and expiate our sins, for your name's sake.**

### ***Second Reading***

### **1 Timothy 2.1-10**

<sup>1</sup> I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people – <sup>2</sup> for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. <sup>3</sup> This is good, and pleases God our Saviour, <sup>4</sup> who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. <sup>5</sup> For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who gave himself as a ransom for all people. This has now been witnessed to at the proper time. <sup>7</sup> And for this purpose I was appointed a herald and an apostle – I am telling the truth; I am not lying – and a true and faithful teacher of the Gentiles. <sup>8</sup> Therefore I want the men everywhere to pray, lifting up holy hands without anger or disputing. <sup>9</sup> I also want the women to dress modestly, with decency and propriety, adorning themselves, not with elaborate hairstyles or gold or pearls or expensive clothes, <sup>10</sup> but with good deeds, appropriate for women who profess to worship God.

### **Gospel Reading – *The Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke Chapter 16 beginning at verse 1***

<sup>1</sup> Jesus told his disciples: 'There was a rich man whose manager was accused of wasting his possessions. <sup>2</sup> So he called him in and asked him, "What is this I hear about you? Give an account of your management, because you cannot be manager any longer." <sup>3</sup> 'The manager said to himself, "What shall I do now? My master is taking away my job. I'm not strong enough to dig, and I'm ashamed to beg – <sup>4</sup> I know what I'll do so that, when I lose my job here, people will welcome me into their houses." <sup>5</sup> 'So he called in each one of his master's debtors. He asked the first, "How much do you owe my master?" <sup>6</sup> ' "Three thousand litres of olive oil," he replied. 'The manager told him, "Take your bill, sit down quickly, and make it fifteen hundred." <sup>7</sup> 'Then he asked the second, "And how much do you owe?" ' "Thirty tons of wheat," he replied. 'He told him, "Take your bill and make it twenty-four." <sup>8</sup> 'The master commended the dishonest manager because he had acted shrewdly. For the people of this world are more shrewd in dealing with their own kind than are the people of the light. <sup>9</sup> I tell you, use worldly wealth to gain friends for yourselves, so that when it is gone, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings. <sup>10</sup> 'Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with

much. <sup>11</sup> So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly wealth, who will trust you with true riches? <sup>12</sup> And if you have not been trustworthy with someone else's property, who will give you property of your own? <sup>13</sup> 'No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money.'
